## Panel for science hub

**Bhubaneswar, Nov. 23:** An all-party House committee will meet Prime Minister Manmohan Singh and Union human resource development minister Arjun Singh to protest the proposed shifting of the national institute of science from here to Calcutta, reports our correspondent.

The decision to set up the committee, which will be headed by Speaker Maheswar Mohanty, was taken by the Orissa Assembly today.

Earlier this month, the high court had stayed the Centre's move to shift the institute. Then on November 11, chief minister Naveen Patnaik wrote to Singh, expressing his concern.
