### BJD heat over NIS

BALASORE, Dec. 25. — The MLA of Bhograi and district BJD president Mr Ananta Das, has threatened that his party would not hesitate to stall the Haldia-Paradip gas and crude pipeline project, if the NIS (National Institute of Sciences), which was scheduled to come up in Bhubaneswar does not materialise.

Mr Das alleged that the UPA government was adopting a step-motherly attitude towards the state. Criticising the Opposition's demand for imposition of Art 356 by the President in view of curtailment of the Assembly session, Mr Das said the House was convened for 49 days which is no lesser than other preceding years.

He also said that the number of days of the state Assembly is far more than several other states of India. He maintained that the curtailment was necessitated as the Opposition brought the situation of political stalemate in the House.
